TELECOMMUNICATIONS (CITIZEN BAND RADIO SERVICE)
REGULATIONS, 2004

The Minister in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 110(1) of the *Telecommunications Act*, makes the following Regulations:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the *Telecommunications (Citizen Band Radio Service) Regulations, 2004*.

2. In these Regulations,

"Citizen Band (CB) Radio Service" means a private two-way voice communication service with a communication range of one to five miles for use in the personal or business activities of the general public.

3. A person who is desirous of providing a citizens band radio service may

(a) on application to the Minister in the form set out in Part I of the *Schedule*; and

(b) on payment of the relevant fee specified in the *Telecommunications (Licence Fees) Regulations, 2003*,

obtain a licence for the purpose.

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4. A licence issued under regulation 3

(a) shall be in the form set out in the Part II of the *Schedule* and shall include a booklet entitled "Rules Governing the use of Citizens Band Radio in Barbados,"; and

Schedule.

(b) is not transferable.

5. Subject to regulation 6, a licence issued under regulation 3 shall expire on the 31st December following the date of issue, and is renewable during the month of January in each year on payment of the relevant fees specified in the *Telecommunications (Licence Fees) Regulation, 2003*.

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6. Where the licensee fails to comply with any provision of these Regulations or any of the conditions referred to in regulation 4, the Minister may cancel or refuse to renew the licence.
