TELECOMMUNICATIONS (NUMBERING) (AMENDMENT)
REGULATIONS, 2008

The Minister in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 110(1) of the *Telecommunications Act*, makes the following Regulations:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the *Telecommunications (Numbering) (Amendment) Regulations, 2008*.

2. The *Telecommunications (Numbering) (Amendment) Regulations, 2003*, in these Regulations referred to as the principal Regulations, are amended in regulation 2 by deleting the definition of "indirect access" and substituting the following:

““indirect access” means the method whereby customers are able to select, on a call-by-call basis, the services of any licensee who uses a public telecommunications network to provide telecommunications services through any form that allows customers to direct their calls to be routed to a licensee with the use of an access code or other alternative dialling arrangement and without an unreasonable post-dialling delay;”.

3. The principal Regulations are amended by deleting regulation 7.
