An Act to amend the Telecommunications Act.

(12th July, 2012). Commencement.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Barbados as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Telecommunications Short title. (Amendment) Act, 2012.

Amendment Cap. 282B.

Section 4 of the Telecommunications Act, in this Act referred to as the principal Act, is amended by inserting the following subsection after subsection (2):

> "(3) The Minister may by Order exempt any person from the payment of any fee or other payment required to obtain or renew a licence under this Act.".

Insertion of Cap. 282B.

The principal Act is amended by inserting the following section IIIA after section 111.

> "Public Officers exempt from licence and renewal fees.

111A. A person who is employed in the public service on a whole time basis shall not be required to pay any fee in respect of the issue of a licence under this Act.".
